Comprehension of a narrative

My past experiences with education

I enjoyed doing maths, geography and arts. I liked to look at history books on the shelf in the classroom. If it was a sunny day we went to the park and played a cricket. It was boring! If it was rainy we stayed indoors and did art or read a book.

From 12 until 17 I went to a boarding school called St John's School for the Deaf in Boston Spa, West Yorkshire. It was a long away to travel by train from York Station to King's Cross. The Journey took me about four hours from home to school. I used to go home to London every two or three weeks for the weekend.
